<sup>1</sup> Includes Bulk Water delivered for resale or governmental uses from a dedicated bulk water fill station. Customers are billed monthly in arrears for water used. Company may, at its option, close account of a Bulk Water - Metered Fill Station customer after three consecutive months of zero usage. Note: Dedicated bulk water fill stations are not available in all service areas.

<sup>2</sup> Includes Bulk Water delivered from an automated standpipe where the customer pays for water in advance of delivery. Automated Standpipe customers pay only for the quantity of water purchased from the standpipe facility and are not subject to a minimum charge. Note: Automated standpipes are not available in all service areas.

<sup>3</sup> Includes Bulk Water delivered from a fire hydrant meter or similar connection for construction and other uses. Customers are billed monthly in arrears for water used.

29 **Surcharge Tariffs:**

30  
31 **Regulatory Expense Surcharge (RES)**  
32 The purpose of the Regulatory Expense Surcharge is to allow for recovery of approved rate case expenses in a surcharge rather than as a  
33 normalized expense. The Company shall recover approved rate case expense until fully recovered with a planned three year recovery  
34 period. The RES will be structured as a monthly charge to a customer's bill based on the customers meter size.

36 The Commission approved a RES for customers as set forth below:

50 The RES shall terminate without further order of the Commission three years from the effective date of Decision No. 81362 (June 18,  
51 2025), or once a total of \$100,000 has been collected, whichever occurs first.

53 The RES will be applicable to Residential, Commercial and Bulk Water - Metered classes, including Re-Establishment Charges.
